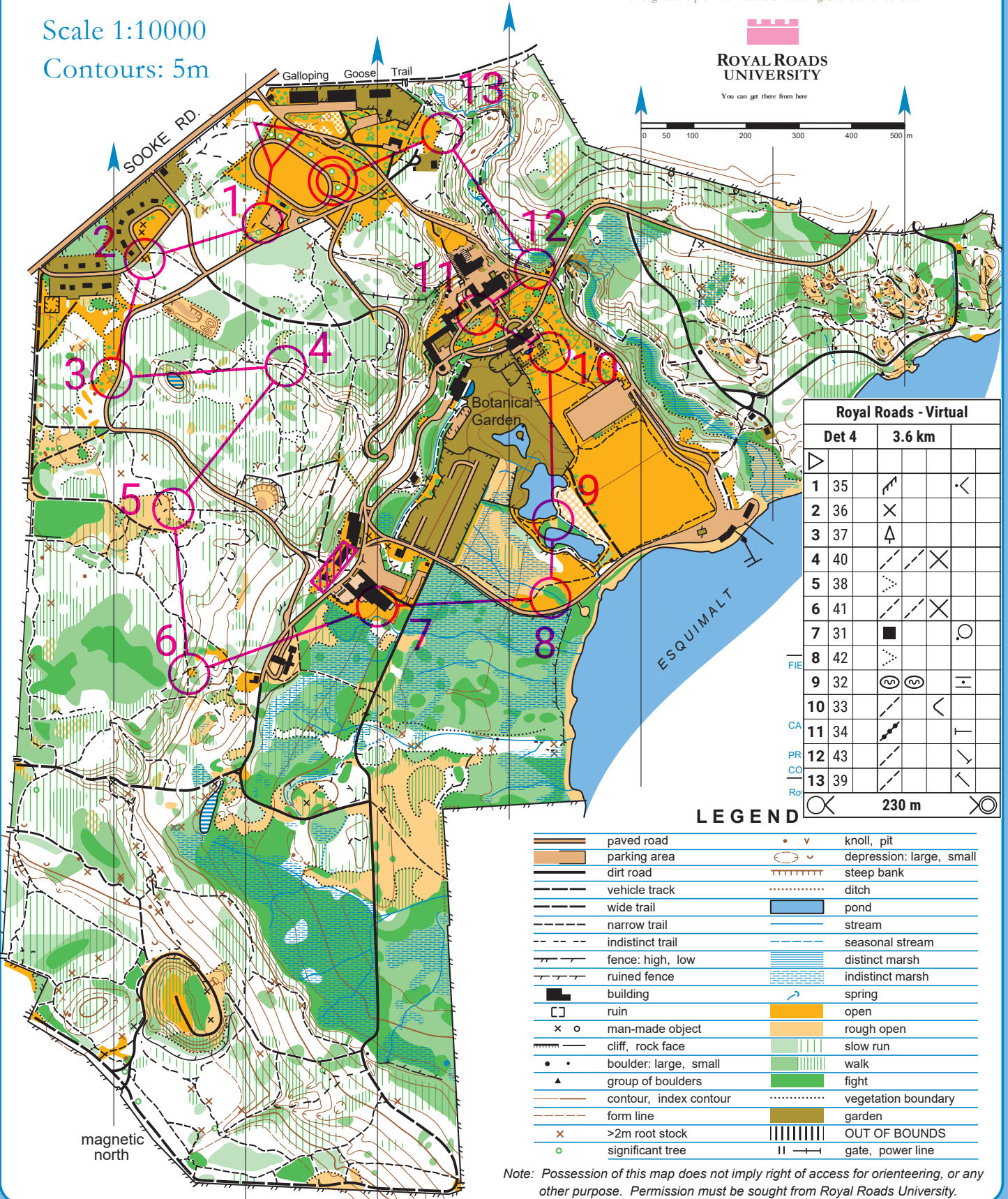


ROYAL ROADS Victoria, B.C.
